Yaxham MNR Walk

Easter Monday 2 April 2018

Join us for a 6½ mile walk (about 2½ hours), starting with a 10 minute heritage diesel railcar ride on the Mid-Norfolk Railway's heritage diesel railcar to Yaxham. The walk itself will be along country paths and a couple of quiet lanes, to enter Dereham over the River Tud. From there, we will return to our starting point mostly along tracks, including a brief visit to Badley Moor, to reach Tesco and so back to the railway station. Here, there will be a drink (tea, coffee or soft drink) and cake at the Station Refreshment Room on return. By then, it will be lunch time, and if you want more to eat or drink, there will be 10% off all further catering purchases made at that time. Children under 5 travel and walk free, but their refreshments will need to be purchased.

The walk starts at Dereham Railway Station (free parking) at 1015 for the 1030 train to Yaxham. It will include a 15 minute short break for those bringing their own refreshments (or who just want a rest).

Well controlled dogs are welcome, though there are limited open spaces and we do cross a number of roads (we walk a short way along some of them); dogs travel free on the railway.

Booking is strongly advised: further details and tickets (£6.50, which includes travel, the walk, and drink and cake on return) are available from any *Dereham Walkers are Welcome* committee member.
