



Dereham Walkers are Welcome Hoe Rough Walk

13:30 Sunday 30 September 2018



The walk starts at 13:30 - meet in the Market Place outside the Assembly Rooms (the corner of Rūthen Place).

The walk will take us across some of the less used parts of The Neatherd, and on to Northall Green. Continuing north, we go on to Hoe, descending through Hoe Common and across Hoe Rough on the fringes of Beetley. We return along Mill Lane (part of Wensum Way) and then down Quebec Road back to the town. *Please note that the route may be changed if conditions necessitate this.*

The walk is 6¾ miles long, taking about 2¾ hours, including a brief rest break part way round. *Please note that there are no toilets on the route, nor do we pass any shops or food or drink outlets until we are back at the start.*

There are no stiles on the walk and just 3 gates. Well controlled dogs are welcome on the walk, though there are limited open spaces and we do cross a number of roads (and walk along some of them).
