

The total distance will be minimal: we will not venture from the town centre as we visit a range of locations of largely historical interest and significance.

Participants will receive a booklet giving information about all the locations visited, which will be expanded on by our guide for the afternoon.

One thing, however, won't change - we will be ending the walk with tea/coffee and cake, once more with our friends at the Mid-Norfolk Railway (though no train ride is planned).
