The walk will take in Neatherd Moor, the Windmill, Tesco (!) and Scarning Water Meadows before we regain the town centre and our welcome refreshment. At the end of the walk, you are warmly invited to stay for our Annual Public Meeting, when you can hear about what we have been doing for the past year, and to help us plan for next year.

The walk is a bit under 5 miles, taking about 2 hours. There are no stiles or gates and just one set of steps. Well controlled dogs are welcome on the walk, though open spaces are limited and we do cross and walk along a number of roads.

We will start at 13:30 from The Wellspring Family Centre, 35 Neatherd Road, Dereham NR19 2AE: limited parking is available by the centre, but please ensure you do not inconvenience the nearby residents. If there are no spaces, the nearest parking is at The Neatherd or in one of the town car parks.
