

Dereham Walkers are Welcome

Garden Party walk

Sunday 29 September 2019

The walk will take in The Neatherd, Dumpling Green, Potter's Fen and the fringe of Scarning Water Meadows before we regain the town centre and our welcome refreshment: this will be tea/coffee and cake served (weather permitting) in a back garden.



The walk will follow a range of paths and tracks east and south of Dereham. We set out along The Neatherd, leaving past the High School then down to. alongside and over the A47 into open country. We then turn further south again to join the **Dumpling Green track** near Borrow Hall. Past a possibly a muddy section, we will cross Yaxham Road and the Mid-Norfolk Railway and make our way through

the houses to Potter's Fen (see photo). We then return north past St Nicholas Junior School to reach the town centre, and, soon after, our garden party.

The walk is about 5½ miles, taking about 2 hours, including a short break for those bringing mid walk refreshments (or who just want a rest). There are no stiles or gates steps, and just a few short steps. Well controlled dogs are welcome on the walk, though open spaces are limited and we do cross and walk along a number of roads.

We will start at 13:30 from the play area at The Neatherd. Please note that there are neither toilets nor food and drink outlets until we are back at the start.
