



Dereham Walkers are Welcome Town Walk

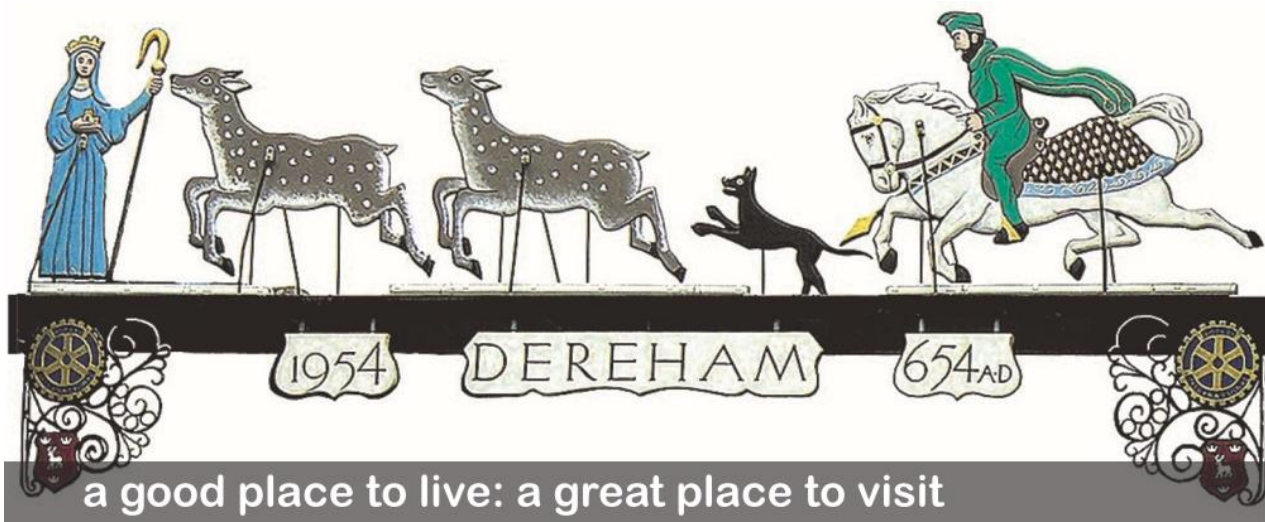

In a break from our usual format, the emphasis of this short walk is on places of interest in the town itself, with an explanation of how and why some things got there. The total distance will be minimal: we will not venture from the town centre as we visit a range of locations of largely historical interest and significance.

Participants will receive a booklet giving information about all the locations visited, which will be expanded on by our guide for the afternoon. The planned itinerary covers the Railway Station, Dereham Memorial Hall, the Explosives Store, St Withburga's Well and the Bell Tower (including ascending to the bells) - and more.

One thing, however, won't change - we will be ending the walk with tea/coffee and cake, this time with our friends at the Bell Tower of St Nicholas Church.

The cost, including the booklet and the tea/coffee and cake, is £5. **Booking is essential, as we will be limiting numbers to 15.** (If there is heavy demand, we may look at running a repeat event.)
