

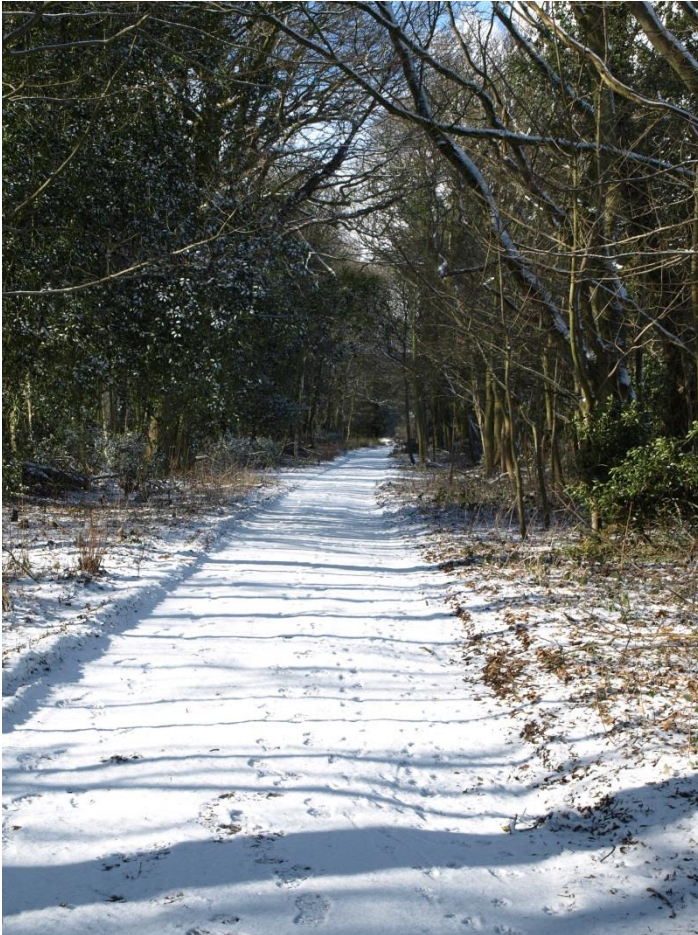


Dereham Walkers are Welcome

Etling Green walk

10:00 Wednesday 1 January 2020

The walk will take in St Nicholas Church, Gingerbread Cottage, Northall Green and Etling Green before we regain the town centre and our welcome refreshment: this will be taken at Coco's (01362 698877).

The walk will set out down Church Street and through St Nicholas Church churchyard, the going up Sandy Lane and across to Quebec Wood, past Gingerbread Cottage. We will continue east along Dereham's sole bridleway and on along Green Lane to reach Hoe Lodge. We then follow Northall Green Lane to Swanton Road to follow a track down to the edge of the Neatherd - but before going past the Neatherd, we go east to Etling Green. The final stretch sees us on Norwich Road and back to our starting point.

The walk is about 6¼ miles, taking a bit over 2 hours, including a short break for those bringing mid walk refreshments (or who just want a rest). There are no stiles or gates on the route. Well controlled dogs are welcome on the walk, though open spaces are limited and we do cross and walk along a number of roads.

We will start at 10:00 from the Cowper Road Car park (entrance off George's Road, parking should be free on the Bank Holiday, but do check). Please note that there are neither toilets nor food and drink outlets until we are back at the start.

Tickets cost £6.50, which includes tea/coffee and cake at Coco's; alternatively, you can use the £5 towards lunch, just paying any extra. Booking is essential: further details are available from Ken Hawkins at dtc.fpwarden@talktalk.net or on 07505 426750.
