Northall Green walk

10:15, Saturday 1 January 2022

Meet at the Ellenor Fenn Garden (adjacent to QD). The walk is about 5 miles long

We will be heading out to The Neatherd, then north to Northall Green. We return via Hoe Lodge and the water tower, and back through the cemetery to the town centre. Seasonal refreshments will be available on return (outside in the Garden), so (1) please let Ken Hawkins know if you intend to come so that we can obtain the right amount, and (2) please bring your own drink of choice - we will provide things to eat. **If at all possible, please let me know by Monday 20 December if you plan to (or think you might) join us.** Email ken-hawkins@tiscali.co.uk or phone 07505 426750.

At this time, there are no Government restrictions related to COVID-19, but we would encourage you to continue to be careful for the safety and well being of all.

We therefore plan that

- the walk will be organised so that everyone normally keeps a distance of at least 2 metres from all other participants (except those in the same group);
- where this cannot be maintained (eg at pinch points and/or when passing other people), a lesser distance will be accepted for short periods; and
- we would like to have your phone number to pass on to NHS Test and Trace if necessary.

A full risk assessment will be completed.
