The spreadsheets we use are all secured with a password and kept on computers which also require passwords to permit access.

# Your rights to access, make changes or asking us to stop using your data

You have the right to ask for a copy of the information we hold about you and to have any inaccuracies in your information corrected. If at any time you wish to see the personal data we hold, please contact us as below. You also have the right to ask us to delete any personal information we hold about you; we will advise you of the results of such deletion (for example, deleting your contact information will mean we can no longer tell you about our activities).
